Sven Kühn Von Burgsdorff

European Commission

Sven Kühn von Burgsdorff joined the European Commission in 1992, with foreign postings to Mozambique (1992 to 1996), Slovakia (1996 to 2000), and Cuba (2003 to 2007) where he was in charge of the Delegation in Havana. He held assignments in Haiti and New Caledonia. He is currently serving in DG Development as an advisor on the Caribbean and the Overseas Countries and Territories. Prior to joining the European Commission he worked for the German development cooperation in Togo and Frankfurt as a GTZ official. His academic experiences include assignments as Visiting Professor in international relations and diplomacy at Hawaii Pacific University (summer semester 2005) and extensive research on the socio-economic consequences of export-led industrialization processes in the Philippines (1982/83 and 1985). Mr Kühn von Burgsdorff holds a PhD in Political Science from Freiburg University (Albert-Ludwigs-Universität) and a post-graduate degree in Development Studies from the German Development Institute (Deutsches Institut für Entwicklungspolitik). Being a German native speaker he is also fluent in English, French, Spanish and Portuguese.
