He has published over 200 academic articles and reviews, and he is the author or editor of 35 books, among them *Cuba, the U.S. and the Helms-Burton Doctrine: International Reactions* (University of Florida Press, 2000), *Las relaciones exteriores de la Unión Europea* (México: UNAM, 2001), *The European Union and Regional Integration* (Miami: EU Center, 2005), *La Unión Europea y la integración regional* (Buenos Aires: CARI/ U. Tres de Febrero, 2005), *Towards the Completion of Europe* (Miami: EU Center, 2006) and *A Historical Dictionary of the European Union* (Scarecrow Press / Rowman & Littlefield, 2006), and *The dollar and the euro* (Ashgate, 2007). He has also published over 1,400 columns and essays. He was awarded the *Encomienda* of the Order of Merit by King Juan Carlos of Spain.
