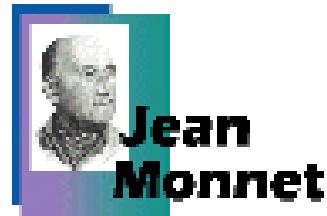

Joaquín Roy is Jean Monnet Professor and Director of the EU Center at the University of Miami. **Roberto Domínguez**, a UM Ph. D. graduate, is Assistant Professor of Political Science at Suffolk University in Boston.

The book is published by the EU Center and the Jean Monnet Chair with the support of the European Commission. Its 9 chapters are written by scholars teaching in universities located in seven different countries in Europe, Latin America, and the United States. The topics range from analytical approaches and theoretical debates on regional integration, case studies of western hemisphere integration and economic cooperation (Mercosur, Central America, CARICOM and the Andean Community) to the model of the EU around the world, with special consideration to the Andean Community.
