The University of Miami Alumni Association (UMAA) Book Award Program honors high school juniors who have achieved academic excellence and demonstrated exceptional leadership skills at selected high schools throughout the country.

Book Award recipients are presented with the following items: the *Concise Oxford American Dictionary*, a letter of congratulations from the UMAA, and an information packet from the Office of Admission.

Book Awards 101
