



As you prepare to join us at the Intensive English Program, you may be looking for a place to live while you are in Miami. If you would like to live on campus in a UM dormitory please read the information below.

The University of Miami Intensive English Program and the Department of Residence Halls are happy to offer a limited number of spaces in the Mahoney/Pearson Residential Colleges during the 2009-2010 academic year (August 19 or 20, 2009, to May 14, 2010).

Costs:

- Residence Halls: \$3161.00 per semester. See www.miami.edu/housing for more information.
- Meal plan: All students in the Residence Halls must purchase a meal plan to include 8, 14 or 20 meals per week. The minimum cost would be \$1,858 per semester for 8 meals each week and may be more depending on the meal plan selected. See www.miami.edu/dining-services for more information.
