Activity # 2, Compiling a Case Study Example of Colonialism
Module Name: A Consideration of Ethics in Chinua Achebe's novel <i>Things Fall Apart</i>
Class type: ESOL ESE Regular Gifted Honors Inclusion All
Objectives for activity: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Identify key moral dilemmas within the novel, and apply them to other "real life" situations 2. Describe core values and the extent to which they apply to characters and their actions in the novel 3. Better understand the universality of ethics
Materials Needed (texts, props, special supplies) <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. a copy of the novel <i>Things Fall Apart</i> by Chinua Achebe 2. computer for online research 3. paper and pen or computer for preparation of case study
Procedures for Teachers- <i>What You Need to Know/Do</i> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Read the novel. 2. Discuss the concept of Colonialism with students. 3. Ask students to research examples of Colonialism. 4. Have students pick one example of Colonialism and have them write a case study of their example.
Activity Type -Discussion Questions, Compositions, Small Group, etc.- <i>What Students Need to Do</i> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Classroom discussion. 2. Online or library research. 3. Preparation of case study.
Assessment <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Student participation in classroom discussion. 2. Student research. 3. Evaluation of student case study.
