Presentations will be selected on the basis of scientific merit by means of blind review.

Topics of interest include:

- *Nursing Research with acknowledgement of IRB Approval
- *Best Practices at the Point of Care
- *Innovative practices to improve patient care

Submission: Authors are requested to submit two copies of the abstract: one with all authors names listed, the second without author's names for blind review. The abstract should be no longer than 250 words (12 pt font).

Presentation Formats

Papers: Authors of selected abstracts will have 20 minutes to orally present their paper.

Posters: A visual presentation for display during conference hours.

Symposiums: A collection of two to three papers focusing on a clinical issue. The session will be one hour in length.
