Subject: New W-4 Forms Required for 2009 “Exempt” Status

Many, faculty, employees, and students filed an Employee Withholding Allowance Certificate (W-4) claiming “exempt” from federal income taxes in 2008. This exempt status expires on February 16, 2009.

To extend your “exempt” status for 2009, a new W-4 (available on the Payroll website) must be completed and sent to the Payroll Office by February 1, 2009. Payroll checks issued after February 16th will not reflect your “exempt” status unless a **new W-4** has been received.

If you are a non-resident alien employee on a visa type “F”, “J” or “H”, you can not claim exempt on a W-4 form. You must complete and submit a Foreign National form available at:
