Re: Student Parking at Broward General


As Broward General patient volumes continue to grow, we find it necessary to enforce that all students visiting Broward General for clinical rotations or for classroom work, park in the 17th Street Employee Parking Garage on the roof level. Since it is a privilege for your students to gain their experience at Broward General we ask that you reinforce this policy during your orientation period. Students found violating this policy will be suspended from further clinical rotations at our hospital. In addition, students are not permitted to enter the hospital from the front entrance. They are required to enter in the employee entrance on the south east of 17th Street and 3rd Avenue.

Students must come to Human Resources with a letter from the department where they will be rotating, authorizing them to receive an ID Badge. The badge will be coded and will allow them free parking in the 17th Street Employee Parking Garage on the roof level and entrance into the hospital.

As a teaching partner we want your students to have the best practicum experience. Included in that experience is the understanding by students that patients and their families come first. Please ask your students to be respectful of our patients and families and to follow these guidelines.
