HOW MUCH DOES IT COST? \$667 per student BUT...the Butler Center for Volunteer Service & Leadership Development has subsidized this amount, so that there is no cost to you except for the required refundable deposit (based on your acceptance to LeaderShape).

WHO CAN ATTEND? Any UM student, in good standing, may apply to attend The LeaderShape Institute. Students must be willing to commit to attending the entire program and must adhere to the LeaderShape Learning Agreement.

Butler Center (UC 240) by **5PM ON THURSDAY, MARCH 1, 2012**. Once your application is turned in, interviews will be conducted to select the students with the best applications for participation in LeaderShape.

WHAT WILL PARTICIPANTS TAKE AWAY? Our commitment to you is that after attending The LeaderShape Institute, participants will

- *Commit to identifying their core ethical and personal values and then commit to act on them.*
 - *Identify when their behavior is not in congruence with their core ethical and personal values.*
 - *Develop relationships where the dignity and contributions of all people are acknowledged and respected.*
 - *Create a vision for the great good of a community which includes a “healthy disregard for the impossible”.*
 - *Develop skills to be able to successfully work in groups and teams to accomplish a collective vision.*
 - *Articulate action steps necessary to implement a vision.*
 - *Increase their capability to produce extraordinary results.*
